Early Bird Registration

Full payment **discount of 5%**, if paid in full by August 22 using a credit card.

Full payment **discount of 10%**, if paid in full by August 22 using cash or check.

New Member Referral Reward

A **\$100 referral credit** will be applied to the referring Member's account for every new Family Membership they refer. The credit will be activated once registration is completed by the new member. If desired by referring member, a "donation letter" will be provided in lieu of the credit.

New Member "Free" Kindergarten Incentive

No Religious School fees will be charged for category "First Child" entering Kindergarten Religious School for 2011-2012 year. Applicable fees will be required for any additional children registered.

Free Membership for Newly Married Couples

Couples married between August 2009 and July 2011 will receive **FREE membership** for their first year at CBE (the 2011-2012 membership year) and the normally required Building Maintenance Fee will be waived. Where applicable, payment for Religious School fees are required.

Men's Club Membership Discount

For new CBE members (includes those who did not rejoin from September 2009 through August 2011 membership Year) will receive a discount of **half off** the \$30 basic membership dues for first year.

Sisterhood Membership Discount

For new CBE members (includes those who did not rejoin from September 2009 through August 2011 membership Year) will receive a discount of **half off** the \$36 basic membership dues for first year.

Some of the programs CBE offers you as a member:

Preschool and Kindergarten

Our school accepts children ages 2 to 5, diapers are OK. We offer a fully-accredited kindergarten and a K-6 after-school program. We have a weekly Shabbat program where the children learn Hebrew prayers. They also learn about our culture as we celebrate most Jewish holidays. Women of CBE (Sisterhood)

Affiliated with the Women of Reform Judaism, the Sisterhood supports the principles and programs of the Congregation. Monthly meetings generally highlight Jewish education and include planning for fundraising events. Sisterhood maintains and operates our gift shop, "Simi's House of Judaica," and raises funds by selling gift-cards for many local businesses.

Men's Club

The Men's Club meets on a monthly basis, normally at the Temple, and holds a monthly Sunday breakfast in a local restaurant. Its primary purpose is to support the Congregation's activities and fundraising events. Men's Club activities include trips, barbeques, men's' night-out, and various service projects promoting fellowship and spiritual growth.

Havurah

A Havurah is a small group of Congregation B'nai Emet member families who meet regularly--with or without children--to share Jewish learning and experiences in an "extended family" setting. The Havurah experience is for people who are seeking a smaller scale Jewish community and are willing to give of themselves and work towards building this unique communal bond. Each Havurah decides its own program based on its own needs.

Programs

Throughout the year, there are opportunities for the Congregation to be actively involved in events sponsored by the Temple and other Jewish organizations. Program activities include our Annual Hanukkah Dinner Show, Shabbat Across America, the Community Seder, and the Valley Jewish Festival.

Social Action Committee

The Social Action Committee works to develop projects to benefit both the Jewish community and the community at large. The primary focus is to meet the needs of our local community. Recent activities include Relay for Life, Mitzvah Day, collecting food for local food banks, Habitat for Humanity and helping several local agencies who provide support for the homeless in Simi Valley.

What Is Havurah?

A Havurah is a small group of CBE members who meet monthly, with or without children, to share Jewish learning and experiences in an "extended family" setting. The Havurah experience is for people who are seeking a smaller scale Jewish community and are willing to give of themselves and work towards building this unique communal bond.

What Does A Havurah Do?

Each Havurah decides its own program based on its own needs. One Havurah might be involved in a self-taught Bible-study unit, while another may be going on a retreat to Lake Arrowhead; another may be inviting speakers in to raise and answer questions on a chosen topic while another may be planning their next holiday celebration involving adults' and childrens' projects.
